BASIC PROBLEM

No GSM access for free software

- ⏻ It's no hardware devices for free software
 - ⏻ No devices no software
- ⏻ Free Software is an Open Door
 - ⏻ Hackers will break in and we don't want that do we?
- ⏻ Free Software Business Models don't work
 - ⏻ We can't make proprietary software
- ⏻ No free software applications

BASIC SOLUTIONS

Pave the way for free software

- Ⓞ Phone hardware is ready for free software
 - Ⓞ Greenphone with GPL'ed Qtopia – August 2006
 - Ⓞ OpenMoko – Soon
- Ⓞ Free Software is secure
 - Ⓞ and sometimes more secure than proprietary software due to code inspection by security experts
- Ⓞ Free Software Business models works
 - Ⓞ Europe's investment in open source reached 22 billion Euro in 2006. 20,5% of all software investments in EU, growing to a 32% in 2010
- Ⓞ A lot of free software
 - Ⓞ Qt based applications for embedded – 1286 on Zaurus
